2008 NATIONAL JUNIOR PROGRAM

NATIONAL JUNIOR TRIALS, CANAMMEX & WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS SELECTION INFORMATION

RCA REGISTRATION: Athletes must be registered with ROWING CANADA AVIRON prior to National Junior Trials to be eligible to participate. All athletes MUST also have submitted a signed Junior Athlete Agreement by May 23rd, 2008 and a Privacy Consent form prior to competition if intending to try out for the National Team (will be available on-line on the RCA webpage).

NOTE: Outstanding debts to Rowing Canada must be paid prior to racing.

NOMINATIONS PROCEDURE: Athletes intending to be considered for the World Championships and/or CanAmMex teams are required to submit their event deposit (\$1500) to Jarret Poitras (Rowing Canada) prior to the first race on June 2nd.

Within two hours of the final race on June 3rd, nominations for the World Championships and CanAmMex teams will be posted. RCA National Development Team Coaches and Junior National Team Leaders will nominate crews. Project crew and coach nomination will be based on results at National Junior Trials and performance relative to Gold Medal Standards during the regatta. Selection to the World Championships or CanAmMex team is based on approval from the VP of High Performance.

***CanAmMex selections will be based on those athletes with the next best performances after those chosen for World Championships.*

Athletes not nominated can request the return of their deposit, otherwise cheques will be destroyed.

By June 10th, athletes nominated must accept nomination and have remaining payment made to Rowing Canada.

COXSWAINS: Coxswains interested in participating with the World Junior Championship or CanAmMex teams are welcome to attend trials and assist with the regatta. It is not mandatory that you attend in order to be selected to the team. Coxswain candidates will be nominated based upon current and past performances (resume), coaching recommendation and an audio or video digital recording of a race and practice performance. Please apply with all necessary items to Jarret Poitras by May 23rd, 2008.

REGATTA: The regatta will be run as an officially sanctioned RCA national regatta complete with officials and medals at South Niagara Rowing Club in Welland, ON. The tentative schedule will be as follows:
