ENTRY FORM and ENTRY DEADLINE

Information regarding how to enter, payment of entry fees and utilizing the required alpha list to create your entries, can be found at the Victoria City Rowing Club's Web site

The deadline for submitting entries is 6:00 p.m. PDT, Wednesday, September 8th, 2010.

As noted in Bulletin No. 1, the entry fee is \$60.00 per athlete, that is to say, \$60.00 per entry in a single scull event and \$120.00 per entry in a pair oared event or Adaptive double sculls event. However, the entry fee for the Adaptive coxed four event is \$180.00.

Late entries may be accepted only if they do not require the addition of another race. The late entry fee is double the respective fee above. Late entries will not be accepted after 6:00 p.m. PDT, Tuesday, September 14th, 2010.

The scratch fee will be \$50.00. The name change fee will be \$5.00.

A provisional draw will be posted Friday, September 17th.

EVENTS

As outlined in Bulletin No.1, there will be 22 categories of racing, including the four Adaptive events, and the non-Adaptive events will be raced as groups. The first, second and third place finishers in each category (within the group) will be eligible for gold, silver and bronze medals respectively.
