High Performance Coaching Applications: 2010

Rowing Canada Aviron is inviting applications from coaches interested in being involved with the High Performance Program for 2010 and beyond.

Full Time Coaches are required to fill the following Program Coaching positions:

- **Training Centre Assistant Coach** (Senior level, U23 and/or Junior) – Positions are based out of the Victoria Training Centre (Men), or the London Training Centre (Women) and fulfil coaching duties as directed from the Lead Coach at each centre. Coaches should be certified or actively completing NCCP Level 4, to be considered for World Championship/Olympic teams, otherwise be fully certified level 3.

The Training Centre Assistant Coach positions are term positions effective until 31 December, 2012. A full job description for the Training Centre Assistant Coach is available on the Rowing Canada website:

Short Term Employee Coaches are required to train and prepare athletes for the following events:

- **Senior World Championships - Senior**, October 31 to November 7, Karapiro, New Zealand. Coaches should be certified or actively completing NCCP Level 4. Coaches would need to be available on or about 1 May, 2010 until conclusion of World Championships
- **Under 23 World Championships**, July 22 to 25, Brest, Belarus. Coaches should be certified or actively completing NCCP Level 4. Anticipated start date is May 1st. Duties include preparing selected crews for Championships including a pre-regatta training camp in Europe.
- **Commonwealth Regatta**, July 29 to August 1, 2010, Welland, Ontario. Coaches should be certified or actively completing NCCP Level 4. The final number of coaches required will be dependant on coaches selected for the Under 23 program. Athletes for the Commonwealth Regatta will be selected from the Under 23 selection pool.

Honouraria Coaches are required to train and prepare athletes for the following events:

- **Senior World Championships - Adaptive**, October 31 to November 7, Karapiro, New Zealand. Coaches should be fully certified NCCP Level 3. The

final number of positions will be identified after NART team selection is complete.

- **Junior World Championships**, August 4 to 7, Racice, Czech Republic. Coaches should be fully certified NCCP Level 3. The final number of positions will be identified in June after National Junior Trials and final Junior National Team selection is complete.
- **CanAmMex Regatta**, late July or early August, location TBD. Coaches should be certified NCCP Level 2 or RCA Coach, Competition – Introduction. A long list of candidates for the CanAmMex positions will be posted by May 1st and final number of positions will be identified in June after National Junior Trials and final CanAmMex Team selection is complete.

All applications will be kept on file should additional coaching positions be required through the year.

Application Deadline: March 12, 2010.

Successful applicants will be asked to complete a criminal record check.

Process:

Interested coaches should apply with their coaching CV and a cover letter including the following information:

- Level of athletes currently working with,
- Preferred areas of involvement,
- Coaching strengths,
- Enhanced coaching skills that are of interest to you (i.e. advanced physiology, video analysis, technology...),
- Specific skills looking to improve upon.
