Rowing Canada Aviron High Performance will host the 2011 National Development Trials in Welland, ON at the Welland International Flat-Water Centre-South Course, May 28 – 29, 2011.

ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries will close on May 16th 2011 at 5:00 pm (Pacific time)

ENTRY FEES AND REGISTRATION

W1X (This event will include Senior, Senior LW, U23, U23 LW, and New Talent athletes*)

M2- (This event will include, Senior LM, U23 LM, Senior, U23, and New Talent athletes*)

M1X (This event will include Senior, Senior LM, U23, U23 LM, and New Talent athletes*)

** New Talent consists of athletes who have been identified by RCA through the Talent Identification and/or RADAR program and / or started rowing after June 1st 2010*

FORMAT

Format will be Time trials, Semi Finals, and Finals

Specifics are as follows:

All Athletes will compete in a time trial.

Athletes will be seeded into Semi Finals based on their ranking in the Time Trial.

(Top 12 to the A/B Semifinals, 13-24 to the C/D semifinals, etc)

The top 3 and bottom 3 in each Semi final will go on to their respective finals.

(1-3 of Semi A/B to the A final, 4-6 to the B final)

* All boats of the same type will compete in the same event; results for the athletes will be awarded based on the classification you have registered for.

For example the following boat classes will compete in the same event: Senior LM 2-, U23 LM 2-, senior M2-, U23 M2-, however final results will be categorized into the classification you have entered.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

The following is a tentative schedule.

Saturday May 28th 8:00 a.m to 11:00 a.m - Time Trials

Saturday May 28th Afternoon / Evening – Semi Finals

Sunday May 29th A.M – Finals

A final schedule will be circulated after entries are completed.

LIGHT WEIGHTS

Lightweight athletes will follow the following adjusted FISA weigh-in format. Athletes in pairs will average.

Crew and Single Sculler weight averages and maximums are as follows:

LM 1x: Maximum 74kg

LM 2-: Average 71.5kg / Maximum 74kg

LW 1x: Maximum 60.5kg

FUNDING

Rowing Canada Aviron has a limited source of funding to support identified athletes to attend this event. Funding support will be based on the following:

- Athletes overall RADAR score and ranking as part of RCA's Athletes Monitoring Program, up to and including the May 9th submission.
 - RCA funding support may be provided to those athletes who have achieved a minimum National Development Centre Status score (350 Points)
 - Achieving NDC status does not guarantee funding. As this program has a set funding budget for support, athletes will be ranked based on their overall RADAR score. Final funding support from RCA will be assigned based on the athletes ranking.

- Once the May 9th RADAR submission deadline is complete, RCA will finalize funding support amounts and contact eligible athletes directly.
- Funding levels will reflect distance traveled

Individual funding support based on the above is limited to a maximum of \$1000 from RCA, pending travel expenses, etc.
