One position is available and would be part-time from September to November, exact dates negotiable with the possibility of part-time work available during the winter training season.

The Halifax Rowing Club promotes rowing as a lifelong sport for fitness, skill development, competition, fun and friendship. We row on the picturesque North West Arm of the Halifax Harbour and have approximately 125 members of all ages, including a very active junior program and an adaptive rowing program. The Coach will organize and teach University Learn to Row classes and competitive level crews of students from Dalhousie and Kings. The Coach will assist with regattas, boathouse and boat maintenance, and general organization and management of the Club including program registration and communication with members.

Candidates for the Coach's position should have NCCP Level 2 or equivalent, or be working



towards this. Candidates need rowing and coaching experience, and have good organizational and communication skills. Special consideration will be given to individuals who have a proven aptitude for boat and boathouse maintenance and/or administrative skills. In addition the successful candidates will need a Boat Operator's Card, and current qualifications in First Aid and CPR before starting employment at HRC.
